 <b>NYSERDA</b>  <b>Air Source Heat Pump Rebate</b>	<b>Base Rebate</b>	<b>\$500</b> per outdoor unit for cold climate air source heat pumps
	<b>Whole-Home Rebate</b>	Air source heat pump systems that provide whole-home heating and cooling will receive a larger rebate depending on the size of the system.
		<b>2-ton   \$1,500</b>
		<b>3-ton   \$2,500</b>
		<b>4-ton   \$3,500</b>
		<b>5-ton   \$4,500</b>
	Additional rebates of <b>\$500</b> are available for systems installed with integrated controls and <b>\$50</b> for a dual-fuel thermostat to coordinate with your existing heating system. Speak with your installer for more information.	
 <b>NYSERDA</b>  <b>Ground Source Heat Pump Rebate</b>	<b>Small-Scale (≤10 tons)</b>	<b>\$1,500</b> per ton of cooling capacity
	<b>Large-Scale (&gt;10 tons)</b>	<b>\$1,200</b> per ton of cooling capacity
	<b>Residents</b> affected by the ConEd Gas Moratorium are eligible for <b>expanded rebates</b> of <b>\$1,875</b> (Small-Scale) and <b>\$1,500</b> (Large-Scale) per ton of cooling capacity.	
 <b>Heat Pump Rebates</b> (ConEd customers only)	<b>Air Source Heat Pump</b>	Up to <b>\$200</b> rebate, depending on equipment efficiency level
	<b>Heat Pump Water Heater</b>	Up to <b>\$500</b> rebate, depending on equipment efficiency level
	<b>Residents</b> affected by the ConEd Gas Moratorium are eligible for an additional incentive of up to <b>\$5,000</b> for geothermal heat pumps installed by Dandelion. Reach out to Dandelion to see if your home will qualify.	
 <b>Federal Investment Tax Credit</b>	Receive a tax credit of <b>30% of the installed cost</b> of your geothermal heat pump system.	
	<i>Note: This tax credit will decline from 30% to 26% at the end of 2019. Act quickly to take full advantage of this incentive.</i>	

At this time, NYSEG customers are not eligible for any additional heat pump rebates. Speak with your installer to learn more about what incentives your heat pump project will be eligible for.
